Kansas City International Airport, 1 International Circle (816) 243-5237

The airport is 25-30 minutes depending on the time of day, and 22 miles from the hotel. The airport is divided into three terminal buildings and allows for convenient curbside drop-off and pick-up, only a short walk from the gates.
